## It is Well With My Soul

*It is well with my soul*. Is it? This is the name of an old favorite hymn. Bible-believing Christians should be able to say this at any time in our lives. Can we? In spite of grief, pain, inconvenience, undesirable circumstances, or other less than perfect conditions in life, we should be prepared to say "It is well with my soul." The circumstances behind this song cause us to think carefully about the state of our soul "wellness."



This hymn was written in 1873 by Horatio Gates Spafford after two major traumas in Spafford's life. The first was the great Chicago fire of October 1871, which ruined him financially (he had been a wealthy businessman). Shortly thereafter, while crossing the Atlantic, all four of Spafford's daughters died in a collision with another ship. Spafford's wife Anna survived and sent him the now famous telegram, "Saved alone." Several weeks later, as Spafford's own ship passed the spot where his daughters died, the Holy Spirit inspired these words. They speak to the eternal hope that all believers have, no matter what pain and grief we experience on earth.

The tune is named after the ship on which Spafford's children perished, the S.S. Ville de Havre.

- 2. Though Satan should buffet, though trials should come, let this blest assurance control, that Christ has regarded my helpless estate, and hath shed his own blood for my soul.
- 3. My sin, oh, the bliss of this glorious thought! My sin, not in part but the whole, is nailed to the cross, and I bear it no more, praise the Lord, praise the Lord, O my soul!
- 4. And, Lord, haste the day when my faith shall be sight, the clouds be rolled back as a scroll; the trump shall resound, and the Lord shall descend, even so, it is well with my soul.

It is good sometimes to take stock of where we are, what we are feeling, thinking, and knowing. Take the following self assessment to see what areas of your life may be preventing you from experiencing a "wellness" of your soul, and what areas may need some prayer and work. There are 100 questions here. That is a quite a lot, but even still it isn't "all inclusive." Think about what other areas of your life may not be experiencing complete "wellness" while you complete these.

Be honest when you rate these statements. We certainly aren't fooling anyone except ourselves. God knows the truth, and most of the time...so do others around us. Look for the scoring and personal devotional information on the last page.



#### **RANK YOUR RATING**

- 500 You are not really here. You are already in heaven!
- **400—499** You can truly say it is well with my soul, but even you could use a little of God's peace and work in your spirit. That's why you are still here!
- **300—399** It is fairly well with your soul, but you often struggle with that peace. You have some areas that need some work.
- **200–299** Your soul is not well. You need to pay attention to those areas that show unrest, a need for work, and a need for God's grace and guidance.
- **101 199** Your soul is in turmoil and not experiencing the peace of God.
- 100 You are dead inside and sorely need the peace of God. It is a wonder that you can survive at all!

We remember the words of the prophet Habakkuk when God revealed to Him the awful plan of destruction of the Jews coming upon them. Habakkuk was indignant that God had not judged his sinful people. This amazing statement of faith indicated this prophets "wellness" in his soul. No matter what, he would be at peace with God, even rejoice in Him. May we be able to say and do the same!*


